- Legal advocacy (LCYC, Team Child)
- Community youth advocates, Alive and Free, Youth LINC, Youth Connection Services
- Free behavioral health evaluations and resources

III. Crisis Intervention:

- Institute for Family Development (IFD) services: HomeBuilders, PACT (Parent and Children Together), FFT (Functional Family Counseling)
- Referrals and joint staffings with CCORS, DCR, ConnectUP, DCYF FTDM meetings

IV. Mediation services:

- Purpose - Provides a venue for safe, structured, and confidential dialogue to resolve conflict and create a mutually agreed upon plan.
- Roles
- Benefits – Increases buy-in and accountability, creates uniquely tailored solutions, retains access to resources and ongoing case management.
