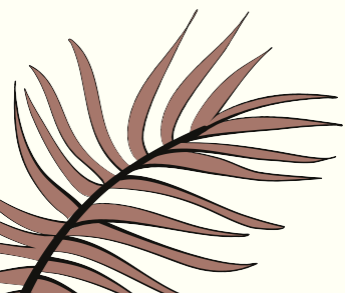
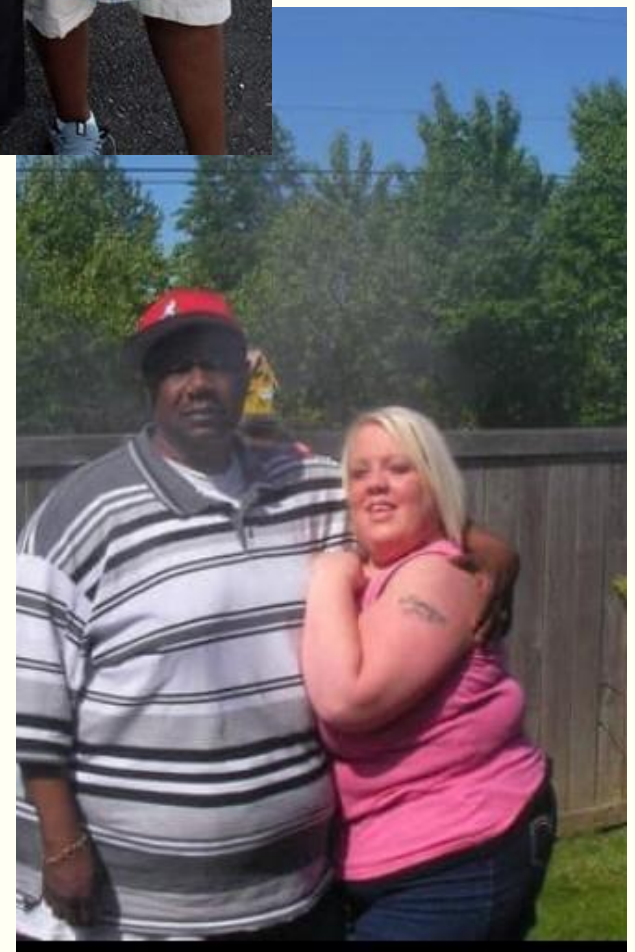
Have you ever experienced or witnessed someone showing bias toward a survivor?
