

### [iEmpathize Empower Youth Program](#)

- The Empower Youth Program is a curriculum developed by iEmpathize based out of Denver, Colorado. The Empower Youth Program is a multimedia prevention curriculum that is rooted and led by the principles of empathy. The curriculum offers 5 lesson unit with short films and discussion questions. The Empower Youth Program has been used in many settings, though largely within school classrooms.

### [kNOw MORE](#)

- kNOw MORE! is a drama-based and student-centered human trafficking awareness and prevention curriculum, for middle school- and high school-aged youth in San Diego County. Though it is based out of San Diego County, this can be a resource used as inspiration for different medium on how to discuss the topic of trafficking through drama

### [Project STARFISH](#)

- STARFISH is an educational tool developed by academics, researchers, social workers, and teachers, designed to raise awareness and provide education about the social injustice of sex trafficking in the United States. This is a free resource for school administrators and educators to utilize that provides a safe and age-appropriate way to educate middle school and high school students on the issue of sex trafficking. This resource also provides ideas for mobilizing students to action in educating their peers about risk factors and warning signs, and taking a stand against sex trafficking. ***All of the content on their website is free of charge and is available for printing and implementing in the classroom.***

### [Child Sexual Abuse Prevention: Instructional Materials Review](#)

- In 2018, legislature passed [SHB 1539](#), better known as "[Erin's Law](#)". Erin's law was developed to help prevent child abuse and is a curriculum used in schools to teach students personal body safety and how to speak up and tell a trusted adult if they are being abused. So far, this law has been passed in 37 states with 13 states pending to pass it. This law requires OSPI to review existing prevention curricula related to prevention of sexual abuse and make the information available to school district. In this review, OSPI identified 38 curricula at elementary, middle, and high school levels which address sexual abuse prevention.

### [Second Step: Child Protection Unit OLT: Module 2, Grades K-5](#)

- Second Step provides curriculum for Social Emotional Learning (PreK-12), Bullying Prevention Unit (K-5), and Child Protection Unit (PreK-5). This resource provides the second module of the Child Protection Unit for free! This module is designed for training elementary school setting staff. The goal of this module is to help staff learn and develop skills to recognize, respond, and report child abuse and neglect.

### [Second Step: Child Protection Unit OLT: Module 2, Early Learning](#)

- Second Step provides curriculum for Social Emotional Learning (PreK-12), Bullying Prevention Unit (K-5), and Child Protection Unit (PreK-5). This resource provides the second module of the Child Protection Unit for free! This module is designed for training early learning staff (PreK). The goal of this module is to help staff learn and develop skills to recognize, respond, and report child abuse and neglect.

## SOAR

- SOAR *Online* is designed to educate health care providers, social workers, public health professionals, and behavioral health professionals on how to identify and respond appropriately to individuals who are at risk of or who have experienced trafficking. The target audience includes physicians, pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, registered nurses, dentists, psychologists, social workers, case managers, school counselors, public health professionals, health education specialists, and allied health professionals.
