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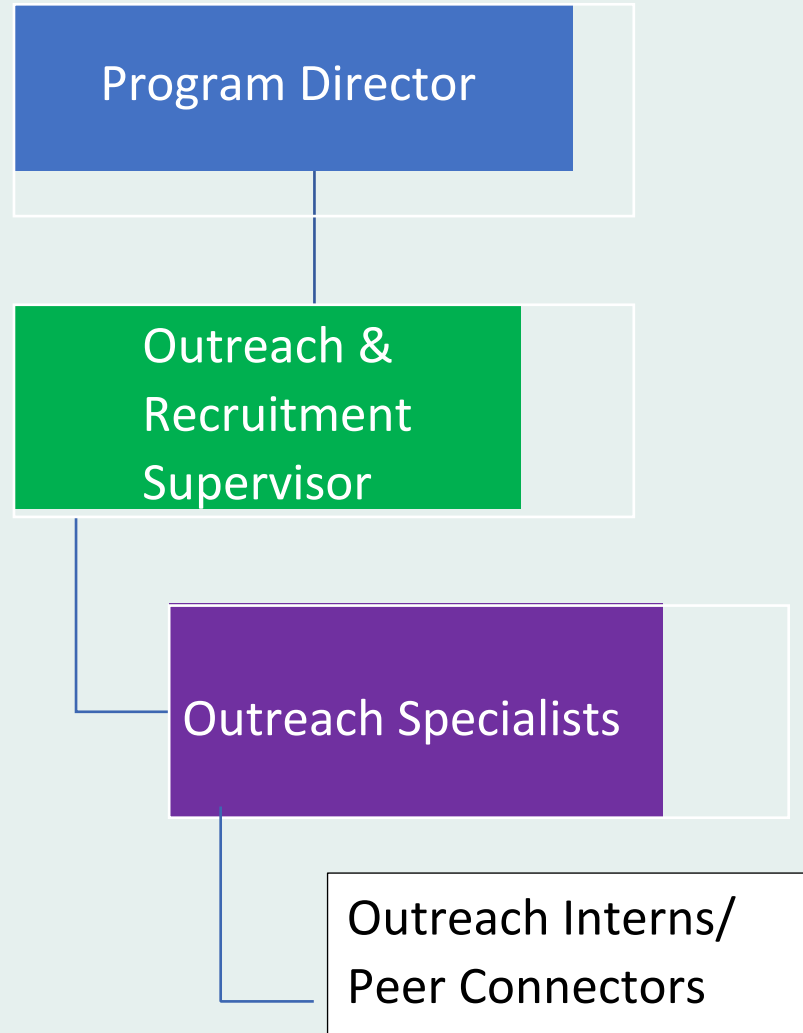
OUR MISSION

WHAT IS AN OUTREACH SPECIALIST?

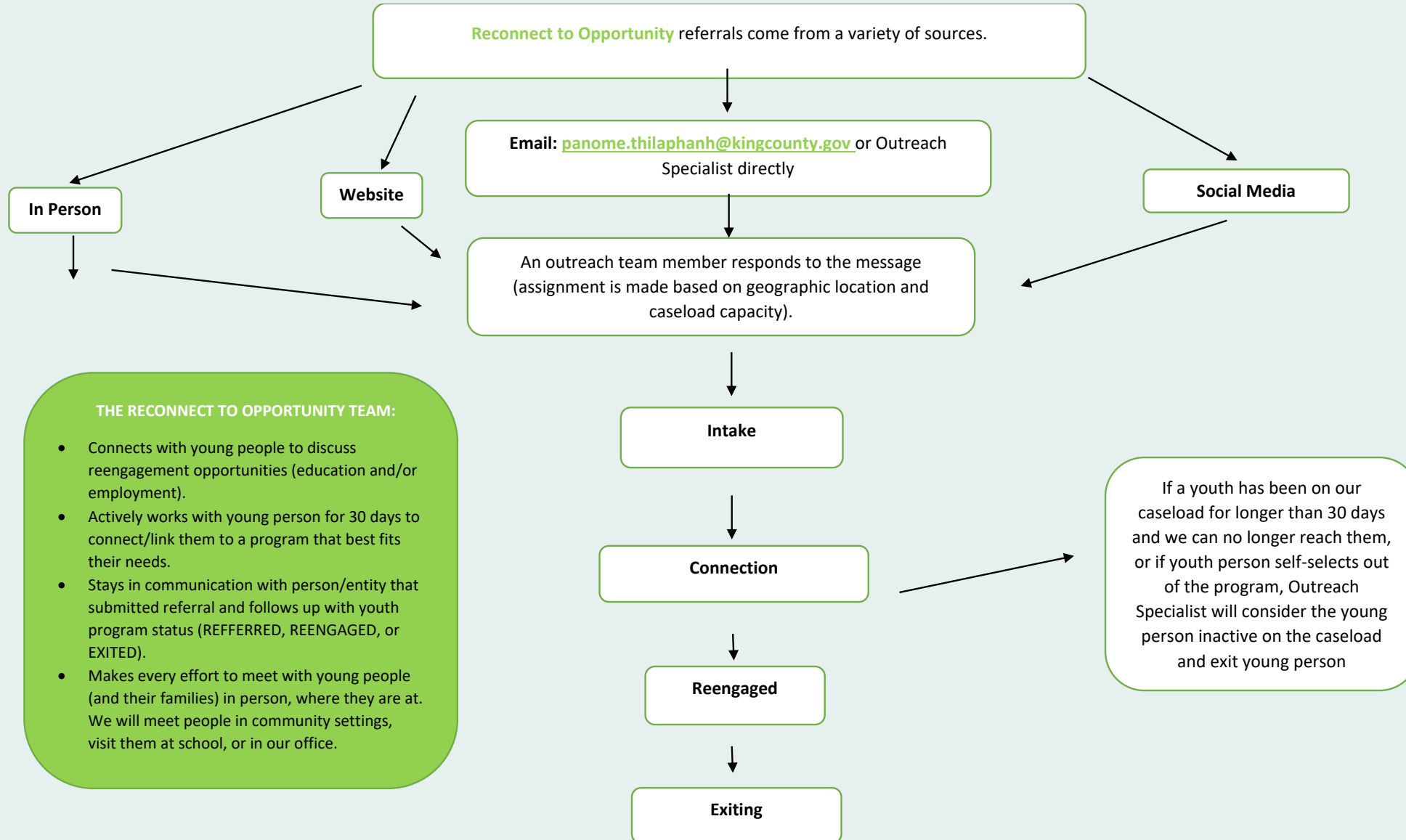
A person who specializes in working with youth who have experienced educational and professional barriers throughout their journey. They work within the community connecting clients to programs that support student centered needs and growth.

Our goal is to ensure you are connected to opportunity no matter your background and whether or not you have finished school.

What we do:

- Look at different reengagement programs that are most beneficial to your lifestyle and learning style
- Help you enroll into a program that best fits your needs
- Connect you to resources that may support other needs (college navigator, case manager, etc.)
- Provide initial guidance to employment services
- Provide the warm hand off when looking into different programs
- Provide post secondary resources after high school completion

THE RECONNECT TO OPPORTUNITY TEAM:

- Connects with young people to discuss reengagement opportunities (education and/or employment).
- Actively works with young person for 30 days to connect/link them to a program that best fits their needs.
- Stays in communication with person/entity that submitted referral and follows up with youth program status (REFERRED, REENGAGED, or EXITED).
- Makes every effort to meet with young people (and their families) in person, where they are at. We will meet people in community settings, visit them at school, or in our office.
